CRATE PACKAGING

After thorough inspection, the rollers are carefully covered with PE-coated paper. This paper protects the coating against ageing caused by UV light.

Coated rollers are best transported in a crate. The roller is placed in the crate in such a way that the coating does not rest on the bottom.

Hannecard has the necessary expertise to supply the most suitable wooden crate and to place the rollers in a transport safely way.

Crates are 'tailor' made depending on the size and weight of the roller.

Therefore, prices for this type of packaging can vary, but Hannecard holds to keeping the rates very low!

YOUR ADVANTAGES

A crate is the ideal way to store your coated roller:

- The roller remains very well protected
- The crate is *reusable* for each transport
- The crates are **stackable**: you gain space
- You can *clearly identify* your spare-parts
- Upon receipt of the goods Hannecard inspects the good condition of the packaging and does all repairs, if necessary





PALLET PACKAGING

When crate packaging does not seem the ideal solution for you, Hannecard offers you the possibility to pack on a protecting pallet. You have 2 possibilities:

Pallet packaging with protective foam

In this case, the roller is put on a pallet with a highly protective high density foam. This way your rollers are safely transported from one location to another.

Pallet packaging with expandable Polystyrene

The roller ends are placed in supports made out of expandable Polystyrene. A protective cardboard and tensioning straps prevent the rollers from moving during transport.

Both packaging solutions are offered at € 40 per pallet and can be re-used.

Rollers that are returned to us on the same pallet for recovering or regrinding, are sent to you with the same packaging without any extra cost after finishing.
